The Novena is a devotion consisting of prayer said every day from December 16 to 24. 9 days to receive and welcome in our hearts the arrival of the Messiah.

Reasons to make the Novena

This tradition helps us maintain family life. Family traditions transmit to our values that are important and must be passed on from generation to generation.

The Novena helps us to reunite and live as a family. There are children, adults, parents, grandparents, neighbours and people who do not believe much about the Jesus Child who is about to be born. Praying the Novena is a wonderful because it turns children into adults and gives children joy.
