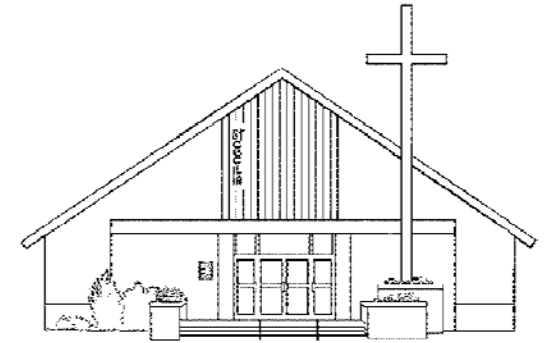

Recently St. Cecilia's parish was able to acquire an **AED(Automatic External Defibrillator)**. This is a small, portable device that analyses the heart's rhythm and prompts the user to deliver a defibrillation shock if it determines one is needed. Once turned on, the AED guides the user through each step of the defibrillation process by providing voice and/or visual prompts. The AED was purchased by the CWL with legacy funds Grace Mario, a long time CWL member & parishioner, and the Mario Family donated.

We are currently looking for **volunteers to take the training** to assist those in our community in a time of crisis. The training will be two hours and offered a few times starting with: **Mon., Mar. 19th @ 7 PM; Tues., Mar. 20th @ 2 PM; Sat., April 14th @ 11 AM and 3 PM.** Please contact Melita to register for one of these dates.
