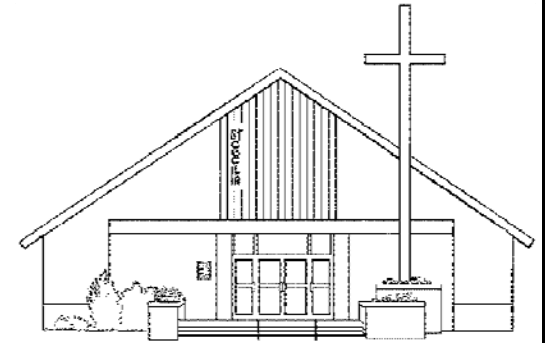

St. Cecilia Medical Emergency Training - In the past a number of medical emergencies occurred during Mass. Thankfully, our hospitality ministers and people at the Mass were able to come to their assistance. Many people say, "I am not qualified for that task". This is not true and the best thing anyone can do is acknowledge there's a medical emergency and call 911 immediately.

In order to increase the number of people who can help in these situations, we are offering training sessions. The training session will include: accessing and using the AED and how to put the pads on, what to watch for, calling for help and getting a first aid kit, how CPR works. The physical requirements are being able to kneel on the floor and strong enough to do compressions in the case of CPR.

Sign-up in the Welcoming Area for either of these sessions: Saturday, November 23 from 10 - Noon or Sunday, December 1 from 2 - 4 pm. Becoming more knowledgeable about handling an emergency benefits everyone and may save a life.
