Starting Your Online Giving

1. Go to www.stcecregina.com.
2. On the Home page, click Donate Now.
3. Fill in the CanadaHelps form.

The day you set up your monthly giving is the day of the month your donation is charged to your credit card. If you want it to be charged on a certain day, complete the form on that day of the month. You will receive an email after every monthly donation to confirm your donation was received. CanadaHelps emails your annual tax receipt.

Like all online transactions, there are processing fees from banks and credit card companies. CanadaHelps looks after these transaction fees and for its services, receives a fee of 3.5% of your donation amount.
