

Archdiocese of Regina Response to COVID-19

As the COVID-19 coronavirus becomes more prominent in Canadian communities, archdiocesan staff continue to monitor the situation carefully. Most recently, questions have arisen regarding when we might consider limiting or canceling the celebration of Mass and other large gatherings in parishes. We have determined that there is no need for the cancellation of Mass or other gatherings for this weekend. However, parishes should be prepared for the possibility in the future, perhaps as early as next week.

The Archdiocese of Regina will continue to be in contact with government health authorities as well as the other Canadian Catholic Diocese and Eparchies.

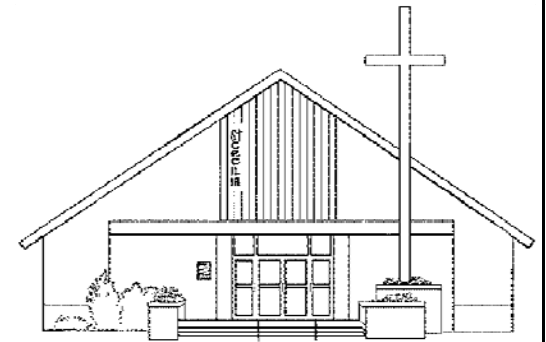
