Covid Update – February 26, 2022

As of Monday, February 28 indoor masking is optional in the province and masking will be optional in all indoor spaces at St. Cecilia. If you choose to wear a mask, we are committed to being mask friendly.

The Archdiocese continues to encourage parishes to be cautious and prudent. The following recommendations will continue to be followed.

The priest will wear a mask during the Eucharistic Prayer.

During the distribution of communion, the priests and extraordinary ministers of communion will wear a mask.

The Eucharist will only be distributed in the form of the Body of Christ and reception is in the hand.

The sign of peace will be offered with a gesture.

A container for your offering will be in the Welcoming Area.

It is important that good hand hygiene continue. Hand sanitizer is available in the entrance and Welcoming Area.

Anyone who is sick should stay home. Although the public dispensation from Mass has not been in effect since August 2021, the sick and medically vulnerable have always been dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. If you are ill, elderly, or medically vulnerable in any way, you are urged to continue to take every precaution to keep yourself and others safe.
